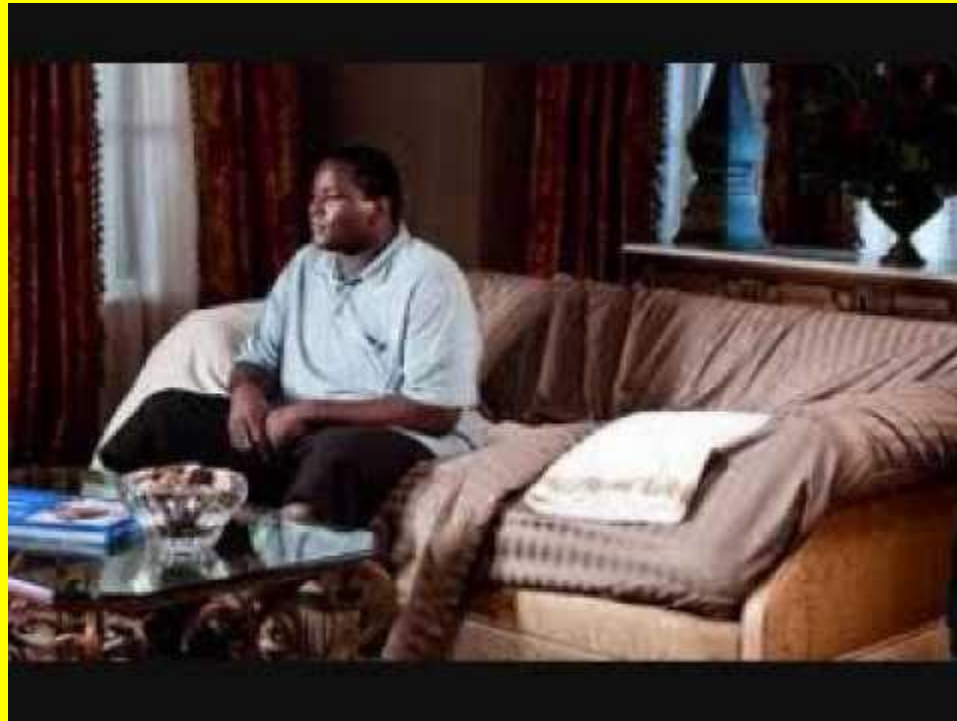


TITLE #1: The Blind Side by Michael Lewis

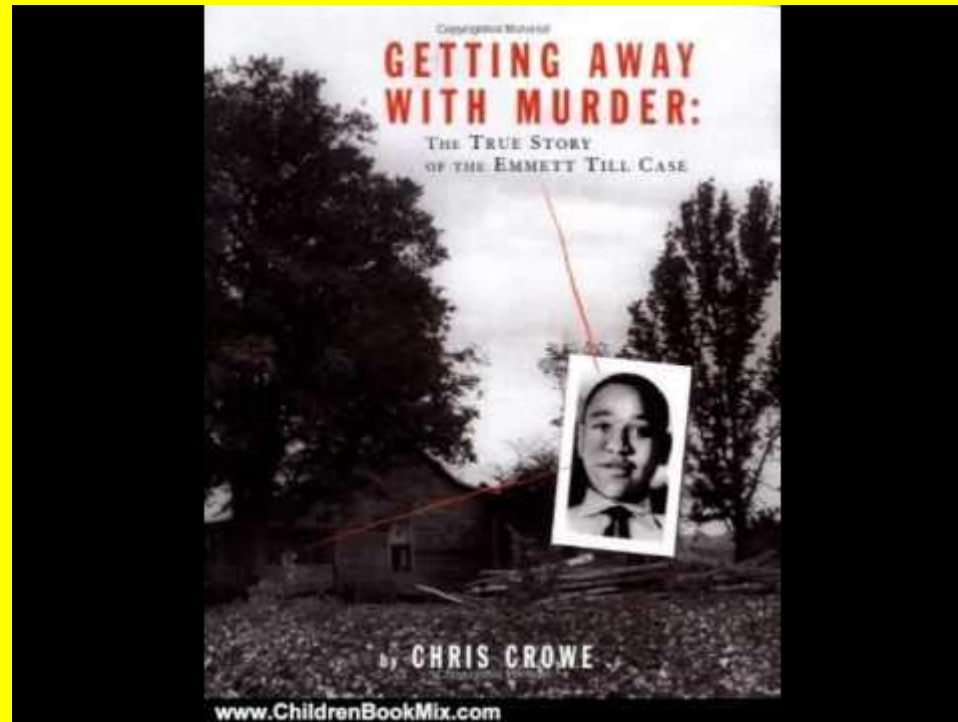
