Mr. Shawn Heeter Update - Dean's Report / School Safety and Security

Attendance is a new evaluative measure under the ESSA (which replaces NCLB). Chronic absenteeism includes absences for every reason (even if they are excused). As of today based on this definition we are at 29% chronic absenteeism whereas we are at 16% truancy (students missing 10% of the school year). The ESSA target is 15% truancy. What constitutes "excused" absences was reviewed. Mr. Heeter asked for consideration on behalf of the Board and asked them to share suggestions for a revised policy.
